No. 24/78/68-DH(S), dated the 24th September, 1968 and in supersession of the Recruitment Rules for appointment to the post of Panchkarma Specialist notified on 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2005 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, after prior consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, is pleased to amend the rules in the schedule annexed hereto regarding the moethod of recruitment and qualification necessary for appointment to the post of Panchkarma Specialist in the Directorate of AYUSH, under the Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi.
