**NOTIFICATION**

No. F.1(55)/Nursing/H&FW/2023- In exercise of the powers conferred under Article 309 of the Constitution, read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs GSR No. 840 Dated 13<sup>th</sup> July 1959 and in supersession of all the previous notifications issued in this regard, except as respects things done or omitted to be done with UPSC, is pleased to make the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in the Department of Health and Family Welfare, namely :-

**1. Short title and commencement**

- (1) These rules may be called the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife's Recruitment Rules, 2022.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay**

The number of the said post, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Schedule columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of Recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.**

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualification and other matters connected therewith, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**4. Disqualification**

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the Service.

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or  
(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person. Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax**

Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Commission/Departments, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving**

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

7.	Educational qualification required for direct recruitment	<b>Essential</b> (i) 12 <sup>th</sup> class passed from a recognized board or University.  (ii) Diploma or certificate course in Auxiliary Nurse Midwife from a recognized institution.  (iii) Registered as Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Nursing with a Nursing Council.  <b>Note 1 –</b> Qualification are relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.
8.	Whether age & educational qualification prescribed for direct recruits will apply in case of promotees	Not applicable
9.	Period of probation, if any.	Two years  <b>Note :</b> Direct recruits would be required to successfully complete a mandatory induction training of at least two weeks duration as prescribed by the Competent Authority for completion of probation.
10.	Method of rectt. Whether direct or by promotion / or by deputation / transfer & percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.	100% Direct recruitment  <b>Note :</b> Vacancies caused by the incumbent being away on deputation or long illness or study leave or under other circumstances for duration of one year or more may be filled on deputation basis from officers of Central Government / State Government/ UTs ; holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department and possessing the educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits under Column 7  (The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not exceed 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications)
