Essential Qualification:- MBBS with Post Graduate Degree/DNB/Diploma or Post-Doctoral Degree (or equivalent, in the concerned specialty in from an NMC/MCI recognized University/Institute and must possess DMC registration for the concerned specialty/super specialty. The tenure of the PG Degree/DNB/Diploma or post Doctoral Degree or equivalent should be complete as well as the result also should be declared before the date of interview.

' (iii) Age Limit:- Certificate of age proof (age limit as on the date of interview - 45 Years for General candidate, EWS & 03 years relaxation OBC certificates (non creamy layer). 05 years relaxation in case of SC/ST. OBC certificate issued from Govt. NCT of Delhi only will be considered.

- (iv) Relaxation of Criteria: In accordance with circular No. F. No. 121/26/2010/H&FW/1996-2045, dated: 10-06-2011 issued by Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. NCT of Delhi, the following relaxation shall be applicable in case of non- availability of fresh candidates:-

 - There is no fee for appearing in the interview and Candidate must bring either DMC registration or provisional DMC registration.
