- An order has been issued to all dedicated COVID hospitals under GNCT of Delhi that no patient who is having COVID symptoms and is in moderate and severe category be denied admission on pretext that patient is not having COVID positive report.
- An office memorandum has been issued regarding "Clinical Management protocol for Adult Patients with confirmed COVID-19 infection" using best practices, ICMR revised National clinical management guidelines and available evidence for patient care, prepared by Department of Medicine, Maulana Azad Medical College.
