Total positive cases in Delhi till date: Three

 Third positive case of COVID-19 in Delhi has been reported from Uttam Nagar. There are 8 members in family, including him, samples of all family members have been collected. The details of contact tracing, home isolation etc of all the cases is as per table given below:-

- 2. In containment plan, Surveillance team has done house to house survey of 50 households in vicinity of the third case.
- A state monitoring group (SMG) has been constituted, under the chairmanship of Hon'ble health Minister to review COVID-19 infection status at hourly level and take necessary actions immediately.
- 4. Total number of Calls received at CATS -23, Number of contacts transferred to RML -12, Safdarjung Hospital -1 and Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital -1
- 5. As per containment plan, Geo spatial Delhi Ltd (GSDL) has mapped a Buffer zone of 5 km around the primary cases reported till date.
- Public Awareness message regarding covid-19 through radio jingle is being aired on 09 Radio stations with the frequency of 60 spots per day.
- 7. A national level training of trainers was held on 6.3.2020 and attended by State level

- officers. Training on covid-19 has been scheduled at State level on 09.03.2020 for the CDMOs/DSOs, DHOs, Nodal officer & Microbiologist of H1N1 designated Hospitals at Delhi Secretariat.
- 8. A review meeting of all CDMOs to assess the activities undertaken related to covid-19 has been taken by DGHS
- 9. Total calls received and responded at State Head Quarter Control Room 41
- 10. Till date, 1,35,343 travellers from corona affected countries have been screened at Delhi Airport and placed under surveillance.
