Sir/Madam,

The E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 amended in 2022 have been notified by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, which applies to all kind of healthcare facilities under the jurisdiction of Govt. of NCT of Delhi

All health entities are required to dispose of their electronic and electrical E-waste and other E hazardous waste in eco- friendly manner with a recycler authorized from State Pollution Control board/ CPCB. This includes 'bulk consumer' of electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule I Shall ensure that e-waste generated by them shall be handed over only to the registered producer or refurbisher, and all end of life E-Waste waste materials (Equipment's) to recycler under the Environment Protection Act, 1986

The Decommissioning of Electronic and Electrical waste and hazardous waste is a crucial step in ensuring compliance with the law and protecting the environment. To fulfill this requirement, you must submit your annual return in the prescribed form (Form-3) and MOU with the concerned State Pollution Control Board/Committee and arrange for the disposal of your e-waste with the registered recycler authorized by the Delhi Pollution Control Committee.

You are further requested to nominate a Nodal officer from your institute for better coordination with the State and the details of the same may kindly be shared with the undersigned. It is also requested to make a list of e waste material present on your premises, more over you are also required to maintain the record of Electrical and Electronic products installed and operational in your premises and submit half yearly report to this office and action taken report regarding disposal of discarded instruments to be submitted in the office of undersigned.

The E-Waste (Management) Rules 2022 are to be strictly complied with and failure to do so or any violation of the same shall result in appropriate action.
