Qualification: MBBS Degree from a recognized University/Institution and must possess valid Registration Certificate from DMC.

Internship: Candidates who have completed internship earlier than 2 year at the time of interview shall not be eligible.

Pay Scale: Pay of Rs. 56100/- as per 7th CPC level 10 plus allowances as admissible under the rules.

Age: 30 years for General, 5 years relaxeble for SC/ST and 03 years for OBC candidates (belonging to Delhi only) on the closing date of submission of application.

Tenure: The Maximum tenure of Junior Residents(MBBS) is for a period of one Year only including any service rendered as Junior Resident earlier on ad-hoc/regular basis in any recognized institution. The appointment will be initially period of 89 days.
